INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTERS

- The poll worker will insert the blank ballot card to activate the machine.
- In bilingual districts, select your preferred language then press "Start Voting."
- Touch the box containing the candidate of your choice; the box will turn GREEN signifying your selection.
- To vote for the PUBLIC QUESTIONS, if printed on this ballot, touch "YES" or "NO"; the box will turn GREEN signifying your selection.
- To change your selection, touch the box again and the box will turn white and you may make a new selection.
- To write-in a candidate, select the "Write-In" box, in the Personal Choice column, across from the office you wish to write-in. A keyboard will appear. Type in the first and last name of the person you wish to write-in. Touch "ACCEPT." Your write-in choice will appear on the ballot.
- When you have completed your selections, touch the "NEXT: PRINT BALLOT CARD" button to view your selections on the window panel to the right, to ensure it represents your selections accurately.
- To make changes before printing the Ballot Card, touch "RETURN TO BALLOT."
- To record your vote touch the "CAST VOTE" button only if what is displayed accurately reflects your choices.
- To change your vote, touch "QUIT" and the poll worker will be signaled to assist you.
